



Increased Animal Safety – Expand the fire protection system to the entire shelter thus ensuring the safety of all of the animals in our shelter if a fire were to occur.

Improved Animal Health – Redesign the kitchen and laundry areas of the shelter to better segregate the soiled blankets from the clean ones, thus minimizing the spread of disease. Also securing the pet food in rodent proof containers to 1) minimize risk of disease transmission and 2) minimize the number of rodent lives lost.

Increased Number of Animal Lives Saved – Double the number of dogs available for adoption by expanding our canine adoption kennels from 11 to 22. Also increase the number of sick animals we can help by building new quarantine.
